



## Dublin ITS PROJECT



### Project Scope

The Dublin ITS (Integrated Ticketing Scheme) project was awarded to MSI by IBM Ireland in Aug 2008, with a project execution phase of 20 months. The expected project completion (including 2 Years Warranty & 3 Years Maintenance) is Jan 2015.

MSI's role is to design, develop, test and maintain the Clearinghouse application software of the following sub-systems:-

- Clearinghouse
- Issuer
- Scheme Monitor

### Project Description

Dublin city intends to integrate their 7 public transport systems to use a single contactless smartcard (CSC) card with stored value e-purse.

IBM Ireland is the contractor to Rail Procurement Agency (RPA), with MSI as its sub-contractor. The Dublin ITS project will be implemented in two phases with Phase 1 to be completed 16 months after the award and Phase 2 in Aug 2010.

The scope of MSI is to supply the back\_office application software for the Dublin ITS system by customising the Singapore's Clearinghouse software. The application software to be delivered includes: Issuer, Clearing House, Scheme Monitor, ITS Access Point and Help Centre System.

Project is currently in the software development phase.
