Project Scope : To supply two units of Magnetic Ticket Encoder/Sorter Machine to Bangkok Transit System

Project Description

Bangkok Mass Transit System Public Company Limited is the owner and operator of the BTS Skytrain. The system consists of two lines, with a total of 25 elevated stations. It began operations in 1999.

MSI Global Pte Ltd was awarded the contract to supply two units of Magnetic Ticket Encoder/Sorter machines. The scope included upgrading and refurbishing the hardware and supply of customised application software.

With the machines in operation, BTS was able to encode magnetic tickets used in their system, without relying on the ticket suppliers.

Progress

The project, including a one year DLP, was successfully completed in June 2004.
